## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

For the week of October 8, 2023

One of the best things you can do after hearing truths from the Word of God is to talk about them with others. Here are some questions to help get the conversation started. (hint: the first couple of questions are meant to "break the ice" and get people talking)

- What is something 'odd' that you do (or a family member does) that leads others to ask, "Why are you doing that?"
- What is one "good/godly" thing that you find easy to do on a consistent basis? (it's ok to say it...it's not bragging)
- What would the average unsaved person say is the motivation behind doing anything considered "good?" What would the average Christian say is their motivation?
- Talk about these statements:
  - "One of the greatest temptations believers give in to is <u>unbiblical</u> motivations for doing <u>biblical</u> things."
  - "If the Gospel is not on repeat, we can easily fall into the trap of trying to live the Christian life outside of a relationship with Jesus Christ (driven by rules and not relationship)."
- Read through Galatians 3:21-26 and talk about what it says about the relationship a Christian should have with the law (10 commandments). Bonus passages: Galatians 4:7-11, 5:1
- It's easy to say that "It's not about rules, but relationship." Talk about what it looks like to live a life that is driven by relationship with Jesus. Be as practical as possible.
- Take some time to pray together.
