

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

For the week of June 9, 2024

One of the best things you can do after hearing truths from the Word of God is to talk about them with others. Here are some questions to help get the conversation started. (hint: the first couple of questions are meant to “break the ice” and get people talking)

- What is something you've done that was really hard/scary the first time(s) you did it, but now you are able to do it with confidence without fear?
- How do you feel about your own confidence in your faith? Can you share a time when your faith was challenged and how you responded?
- How do you handle doubts about your faith? Do you see doubt as a weakness or an opportunity for growth?
- Talk about this statement, “Doubt is a part of faith; it drives us to seek, to ask questions, and to grow.”
- Read John 7:25-27. What did the men in this passage do that kept them from growing in their faith?
- What are some common challenges to faith you've encountered or observed in others? How do these challenges affect confidence in faith?
- In what ways do we “embrace ignorance” as believers?
- What distinguishes true confidence from false confidence in one's faith? How can we build true confidence?
- What does it mean to have your identity rooted in Christ? (Ephesians 1) How does this understanding affect your daily life and confidence?
- How does believing in God's sovereignty influence your confidence in facing life's challenges?
- Take some time to pray together.

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
